Project Summary:

Backstage to the Future (BsF) is a three-year project co-funded by the European Union and the British Council, and implemented by the British Council, in partnership with the Vietnam National Institute of Culture and Arts Studies (VICAS) and the Viet Nam National University Youth Union in Hanoi (VNUYU) between 2021 and 2024. The project's overall objective is to contribute to enhancing the role of CSOs in Viet Nam's efforts to combat human trafficking. The specific objective of the project is that grassroots CSOs employ innovative approaches to mobilise and sensitise all levels of society (public, private, civil) to respond to the problem of human trafficking and unsafe migration in 10-15 hot-spot source communities in Hai Phong, Quang Ninh, Nghe An, Ha Tinh and Quang Binh provinces.
