How to develop the relationship?

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
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3. FTU- RALACO linkages

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FTU – RALACO linkages

1. Driver of the initiation phase: (From RALACO)

- Direct **Communication** between Ralaco's CEO and Director of iEIT (FTU)
- Reputation of FTU, esp. in BSC&KPI training
- **Synergy:** demand of RALACO in improving management

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FTU – RALACO linkages

2. Driver of the engagement phase:

- Communication: Bi-directional, top-down and wideorganisation
- Understanding demand of RALACO
- Trust: based on results of previous work

3. Moving to Advancement phase:

- Further discussion: Beyond projects to on-going activities
- Expansion benefits: reputation for both FTU and RALACO
