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An Update on Singapore Universities

- The two older universities: National University of Singapore and Nanyang Technological University
- Singapore Management University was added in 2000, and three more universities added in the last 10 years: Singapore University of Technology and Design, Singapore Institute of Technology and UniSIM College
- By 2020, 40% of every primary one cohort will get places in universities funded by the Ministry of Education
- There is great diversity in the sector
