



- ✓ Newton Fund GBP10,000/person/year to supplement tuition fee and living expense in the UK










NUMBER OF JTPS




JTPS ALLOCATED BY CITIES




JTPS ALLOCATED BY MAJORS




JTPS ALLOCATED BY COUNTRIES AND TERRITORIES (32 countries and territories)

JTPS ALLOCATED BY LEVELS











- Decree No. 73/2012/NĐ-CP on 26/9/2012 by Government on international cooperation and investment on education.
- Joint Circular No. 29/2014/TTLT-BGDDT-BTC-BLDTBXH on 26/8/2014 on finance, accounting, auditing and taxation management on international cooperation and investment on education, training and vocational training.
- Circular No.34/2014/TT-BGDĐT on 15/10/2014 By Minister of MOET on instruction for implementation of some articles on Decree No. 73/2012/NĐ-CP.
- Decree No. 77/NQ-CP on 24/10/2014 by Government on pilot of innovation on operation mechanism of public higher education agencies


VIETNAM: OUTBOUND STUDENTS

- ☐ Around 130,000 Outbound students (2015)
- ☐ Only around 5% Scholarships:
 - + Vietnamese Government (Projects: 322, 911, 165, MARD, MOIST, Local Governments....);
 - + Foreign Governments (Top: Russia (800), Australia, Hungary, Japan, Germany....);
 - + Universities, International Organizations, Projects (Institutional Bi-lateral Agreements, WB, ADB ...)
- ☐ Around 95% other sources of funding (i.e. self funded)

VIETNAM: SENT OVERSEAS WITH GOVERNMENT FUNDING (2015)




VIETNAM: TOP OUTBOUND COUNTRIES (2015)



VIETNAM: INBOUND STUDENTS

- ☐ Over 20,000 students (2015)
- ☐ Government agreement scholarships (60%):
 - + Over 20 countries: Laos, Cambodia, China, Angola, Mozambique, Russian, Bulgaria, Hungary, Rumania, Mongolia, Ukraine....;
 - + Highest numbers are from ASEAN
 - + Subjects: variety
 - + Language: Vietnamese/English
- □ Around 40% other sources of funding (i.e. self funded)
 - + US, Germany, France, Australia...

WHAT DO WE DO TO ENHANCE STUDENT MOBILITY?

- Encourage International Integration in Education
- Encourage Foreign investment in Education
- Encourage Vietnamese universities to cooperate in research and teaching...
- Encourage credit transfer
- Encourage student exchange, lecturer exchange...
- Encourage international accreditation
- Encourage programs delivered in English...

TO ENHANCE STUDENT MOBILITY:

- Summer Camp: Organizing International summer schools - Consider the development of International Summer Camp with partner universities in order to act as a 'taster' for a longer period of study abroad
- Study in Vietnam portal/website → online application form for admissions → better and more systematic information and guidance available to Vietnamese Institutions and potential International Students → data collection on incoming student mobility.

POLICY UPDATES

- Law on Higher Education, approved by the National Assembly on 18 June 2012 and effective as 1 January 2013. 1 Chapter on International Cooperation (Chapter VI with 6 Articles)
- Decree No. 73/2012/ND-CP on Foreign Cooperation and Investment in Education dated 26 September 2012, Effective 15 November 2012, providing stipulations on Foreign Cooperation and Investment in Education, including (1) joint training, (2) educational establishments with foreign investments and (3) foreign educational representative offices in Vietnam.

POLICY UPDATES

- Project 911: Decision No. 911/QĐ-TTg dated 17 June 2010 of the Prime Minister Approving the Training Initiative Project for Educators of Tertiary Institutions to pursue and attain doctoral degrees for period 2010-2020.
- Project 599: Decision No. 599/QĐ-TTg dated 17
 April 2013 of the Prime Minister approving the Overseas Training Program for Vietnamese.

POLICY UPDATES

- National Foreign Languages 2020 Project: Decision No. 1400/QĐ-TTg dated 30 September 2008 of the Prime Minister Approving the National Foreign Language Project for period 2008-2020.
- Decision 2448/QĐ-TTg dated 16 December 2013:
 International Integration on Education and Vocational
 Training by 2020
- New visa category for students from 2015: Code: DH valid up to 12 months
