

Scoping study – Digital Transformation in Viet Nam higher education

Request for Expression of Interest (EOI) from Vietnamese consultant(s)

Context

The Vietnamese research team is expected to work with the UK consultant (selected by British Council) to deliver the key roles and responsibilities as below:

• provide literature review of current policies and report on digital transformation in Viet Nam

- conduct data collection including online, offline, f2f interview, focus group, interpretation and translation with the supervision of UK consultant(s)
- collaborate on initial report writing as agreed with UK consultants
- facilitate/coordinate administrative and logistics arrangement for workshops, webinars and visits (if travel allows)

- experience of development insights report and provision of policy advisory (preferable)
